







SUPER SOPPER INSTRUCTIONS

<p>Tighten the squeeze roller screws. The roller needs to be level and even. This ensures the water soaked up by the sponge is released into the water storage tank.</p>	 
<p>Lift the handle up so machine is in an upright position and the roller is on the ground.</p> <p>Check the drainage pipe is in an upright position.</p>	
<p>Roll the court.</p> <p>When you have finished, move the machine to a drain. Empty the tank by turning the drainage pipe to point down towards the drain. Water will pour out.</p>	
<p>Hose off the machine after use.</p> <p>Hose out the internal water storage tank.</p> <p>Return the machine to court 5.</p> <p>Try to roll over a dry surface.</p> <p>Release the squeeze roller screws.</p> <p>Return the drainage pipe to an upright position.</p>	
<p>Push the handle down to the ground. This lifts the machine up onto its jockey wheels, lifting the sponge off the ground.</p> <p>The machine MUST be stored so there is no pressure placed on the foam roller.</p>	
<p>Cover with the tarp and attach the tarp with bungee cords and hooks provided.</p>
