



## Regulation Hockey Goals Assembly Instructions



### Each Hockey Goal Consists of:

- 1 x End Frames
- 2 x Side Frames
- 1 x Net
- 1 x Box

### Box Contains:

- 4 x M12 x 75 Bolts
- 6 x M12 x 130 Bolts
- 2 x Wheel Assemblies
- Cable ties

### Assembly Guide:

Assemble the goal as close as practical to where it is to be used.

1. Identify all the parts.  
If you are assembling a pair of goals, then ensure that you are assembling 1 x left hand side goal and 1 x right hand side goal.
2. With assistance, position the side frames face down and position the front cross bar ready to be bolted.
3. Using the M12x75, fix the cross bar into place. The one with net hooks attached goes at the front of the goal, the plain one attached to the back.
4. Bolt the side frames and end frames together using the two of the M12 x 130 bolts provided
5. Repeat all steps for the opposite goal
6. Open up the net and drape it over the assembly goal frame. The net is held in place by stretching it over the net hooks on the frame.
7. Cable ties are also provided so that you can secure the net to the frame more permanently
8. By using the handles on the outside of each side frame, the front of the goal can now be lifted by two people and the goal rolled on its wheels and into position
